SYNOPSIS

SPECIAL COMMISSION ON IRAQ

Ambassador Rolf Ekeus, Executive Chairman of the Special Commission on Iraq, reviews the ongoing work of the Commission in carrying out its mandate under Security Council Resolution 687. While a lot has been achieved in eliminating Iraq's weapons of mass destruction, Ambassador Ekeus believes that Iraq has not yet provided the Commission with all data on its military capability. Under Resolution 687, Iraq is obliged to cooperate fully with the Commission before lifting the sanctions.
