## EL SALVADOR

Alvaro de Soto, Senior Political Adviser to the United Nations Secretary-General, discusses the normalization process in El Salvador. The Commission on Truth recommends a national campaign for the country to let go of its past as a vital element for the full and speedy reconciliation of their society. Mr. de Soto believes that judicial reforms agreed upon in the Peace Accords should be implemented, as there is a general trend in favour of judicial changes in this Central American country, and warns that parties to any conflict should be held accountable for their activities during times of hostilities. Mr. de Soto indicates that the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean (ECLAC) is actively engaged in the economic revitalization and integration of El Salvador.
