IRAQ

Amb. Rolf EKEUS, Executive Chairman of the United Nations Special Commission on Iraq, reviews the work of the Commission in light of recently increasing Iraqi cooperation and new revelations regarding their weapons programmes. Iraq's chemical and biological capability was much bigger and more dangerous than was previously known by the Commission. When Iraq offers credible documents indicating that their weapons have been destroyed, the Commission will move quickly to recommend lifting the sanctions. Ambassador Ekeus believes that Iraq is no longer a threat to the countries of the region.
